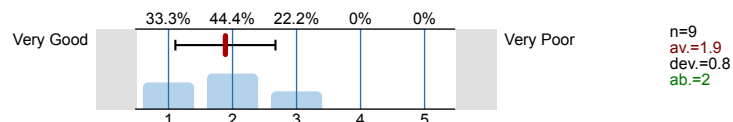
He is a good teacher; explains each question step-by-step & is willing to take time out directly after the class to explain queries.

Class are interesting and he helps make it intellectually stimulating.

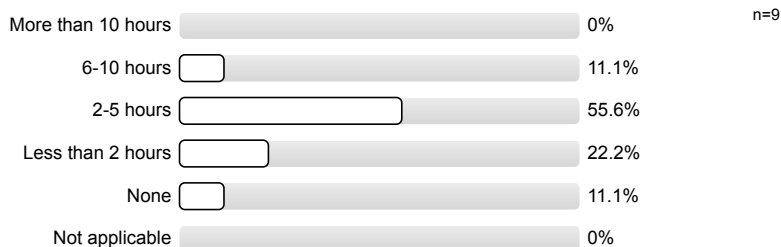
Very clear teaching; workings are clear & made simple. Every question is explained and answered appropriately with the help of useful diagrams.

Improve Lectures, not very engaging/stimulating.

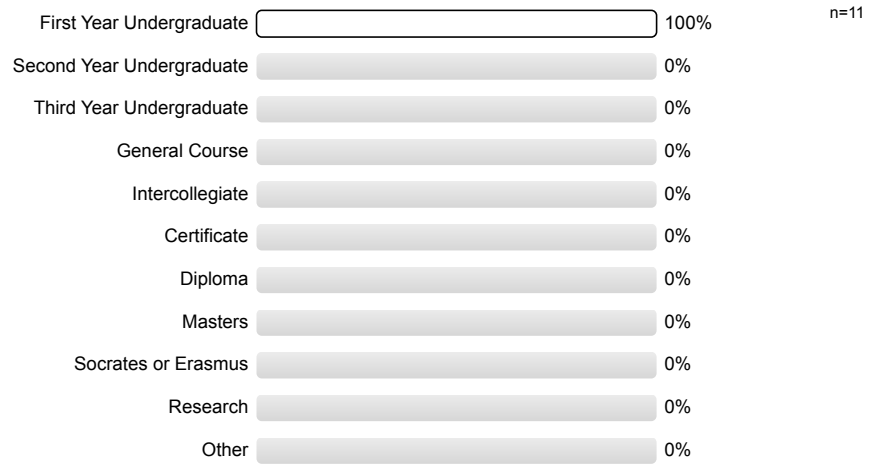
The course needs to define its syllabus better. ~~To~~ Also unify class & lecture material.

There could be more practice questions or problem sets to give students better understanding on a topic.

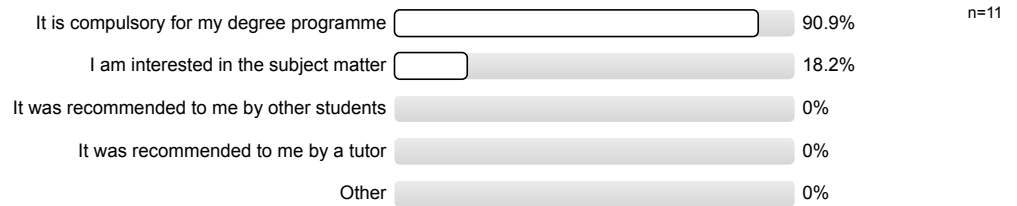
